## T O U R N A M E N T   R U L E S

1. All games will be played according to AHAUS rules with the following time allotments:

	Time of Periods	Penalties		
		Minor	Major	Misconduct
<b>SQUIRT &amp; PEEWEE</b>	12 min. stop	1½ min.	4 min.	7 min.
<b>BANTAM &amp; MIDGET</b>	15 min. stop	2 min.	5 min.	10 min.

2. Any player or team official receiving a game misconduct in a tournament game will not be permitted to participate in the next game.
3. A two-man referee system will be used.
4. Winners will be determined in each division as follows:
  - A. Team with most points (win-2 pts. - tie-1 pt. - loss- points)
  - B. In the event of a tie, the following formula will be used:
    - (1) using the results of the games played between the tied teams in this order:
      - (a) the points acquired in these games
      - (b) subtracting goals scored against from goals scored in these games
      - (c) fewest goals scored against
    - (2) if after applying the above formula there is still a tie, (b) and (c) shall be applied to all games played by each team in the tournament.
    - (3) If all the foregoing fails, there will be a shootout using five players from each team.
5. Team trophies and individual trophies will be awarded for first and second place in each division. All participants will receive a remembrance.
6. All teams must present an AHAUS roster at the start of the tournament. Only rostered players will be permitted to participate.

Second, it seals the handle fibres completely from moisture to prevent leaks and consequent delamination.

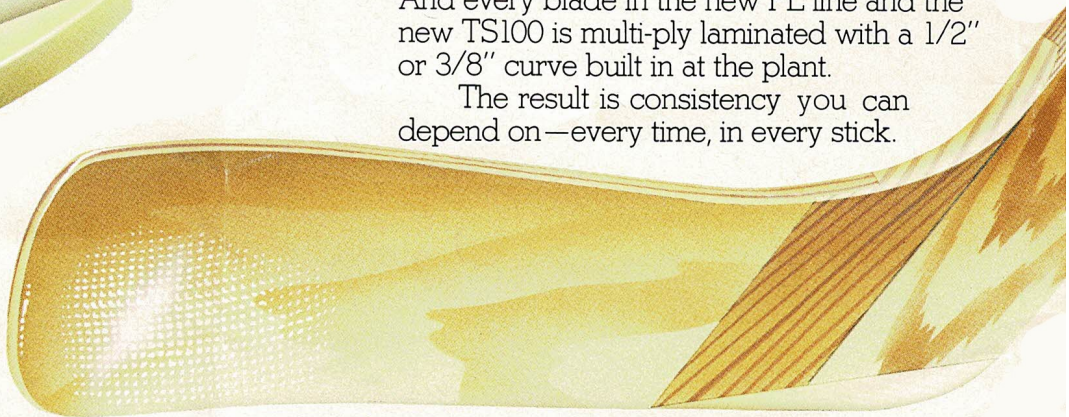
Third, the heel—which takes most of the pressure of the game—is completely protected from wear. The new Cooper heel starts strong, stays strong, and won't come out.


